## RMF – RoHS / REACH Compliance Declaration

We strive to meet and exceed all environmental regulations as outlined in the US and abroad as applicable. This includes the EU Directives regarding items that are “RoHS” and “REACH” Compliant. Below is information to assist in meeting your environmental policies and procedures.

### RoHS Compliance Information

Regarding Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the council of June 8, 2011 and Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of March 31, 2015 on the restriction of certain hazardous substances in the electrical and electronic equipment, we hereby indicate that our products are defined as “RoHS-compatible”, per the requirements. RMF products are defined as not containing any of the following substances at the maximum concentration limits of 0.1% for Pb, Hg, Cr(VI), PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP and 0.01% for Cd.

### REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemical Substances) Compliance Information

We hereby indicate our awareness and evaluation of the “REACH” directive according to REGULATION (EC) No. 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (“REACH-REGULATIONS”).

Regarding this regulation, currently there are 201 SVHC’s (Substances of Very High Concern) as having a potential to be harmful. This regulation outlines in Article 33 that it is our duty to disclose any of the listed substances that are at a level of 0.1% or higher of the article weight. After review, we do not have any substances above the threshold limit currently established by the REACH directive.
